Vocabulary	Meaning
ancient	a thing of the past and no longer in existence
form	a particular way something appears
sculpture	representing something using clay, carving, casting or other shaping techniques
pottery	pots, dishes or other work made out of fired clay
dynamic	expressing an action or activity
sketch	a rough drawing of something
technique	the way of doing something
mouldable	able to be modelled or moulded into a certain shape
armature	a framework on which a sculpture is moulded
sculpture	representing something using clay, carving, casing or other shaping techniques
three dimensional	solid shape, not flat
form	three dimensional objects
detail	decorative feature of a building or work of art
materials	things needed for an activity
combined	join or merge to form a single unit
sculptor	a person who creates sculpture
tool	a device or implement (usually held in the hand) needed to complete a task
proportion	a particular or suitable relationship in size to the whole

Key knowledge - Types of sketches

One sketch type is a gesture drawing this is a drawing that shows a movement of part of the body, especially a hand or the head, to express an idea or meaning. A famous gesture drawing is called discobolus which was made into a sculpture.



Key knowledge - Techniques for creating a sculpture

A sculpture can be created by using the materials wire, foil and clay.

- 1. First use wire to create a armature as a frame.
- 2. Fill with foil as a filler material
- 3. Cover with a layer of clay and add detail
