Key knowledge - Creating depth
Artists use different layers in their artwork called the background, foreground and middleground to create depth.


Key knowledge - Famous artworks
Artists use layers of colour in their artwork to create depth. A famous piece of artwork to do this is Starry Night by Vincent Van Gogh.
