stylus	an ancient writing tool with a pointed end used for marking or writing
laws	rules for what you can or cannot do based on ideas about what is right and wring
justice	fairness is the way that all people are dealt with

Key knowledge - What is cuneiform?

Cuneiform is Mesopotamian writing made up of marks or letters shaped like wedges. This was drawn on clay tablets by pressing a stylus into clay.

It was used to write stories or personal letters.



This is a clay tablet with special writing called cuneiform.

Key knowledge - What is a ziggurat?

A ziggurat looks like a stepped pyramid and it was made of mud-bricks. A ziggurat had stairs leading to a gate and this lead to a temple at the top. The temple is where the people of the city went to worship the god of the city.
