Christmas	the time of year when Christians celebrate the birth of Jesus
Wise men	Magi who travelled from afar to visit Jesus
shepherds	a person whose job is to take care of sheep and move them from one place to another
inn	a guesthouse, hotel or motel
Bethlehem	the place Mary and Joseph travelled to, where Jesus was born
stable	a building set apart and adapted for keeping animals
Christian Nativity	the story of the birth of Jesus. Told in two gospels within the bible.
gospel	teachings of Jesus Christ and the Apostles
bible	the Christian Holy Book, which contains the old and new testament
