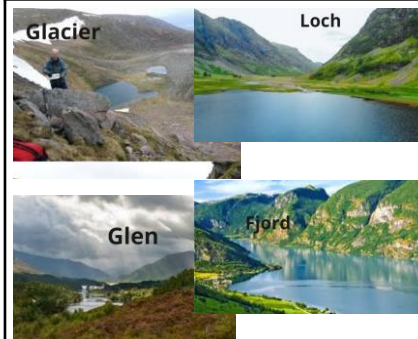


Vocabulary	Meaning
United Kingdom	A kingdom in Europe that contains 4 countries.
Scotland	A division of the United Kingdom. Its capital city is Edinburgh.
England	The largest division of the United Kingdom. The capital city is London.
Northern Ireland	A part of Ireland. The capital city is Belfast.
Wales	A country in the United Kingdom. The capital city is Cardiff.
English	People who live in England.
Land	Part of the Earth not covered in water.
Culture	The ideas of a group of people.
Tradition	Beliefs and customs handed down.
Mountain	A land mass with great height and steep sides.
Loch	A Scottish lake.
Fjord	A long narrow piece of water near the sea and in-between high land.
Glen	A small narrow valley.
Valley	A lower piece of land between two mountains.
Glacier	A large mass of ice.
Volcano	A hole in the Earth that lava and ash can escape from.
Boulder	A large rock.

Key knowledge – What is the landscape of Scotland like?



Scotland has many lakes, mountains and lots of islands off its mainland – over 790 to be precise!

It is also home to the UK's highest mountain, Ben Nevis, and a capital city, Edinburgh, which attracts thousands of tourists every year.

Key knowledge – What is the Cloughmore stone?



The Cloughmore Stone is a large granite boulder 230m above sea level – legend has it Finn MacCool threw the Cloughmore Stone.
