

Vocabulary	Meaning
Shading	the darkening or colouring of an illustration
Value	The lightness or darkness of a colour
Texture	the feel, appearance, or consistency of a surface or substance
Hatching	Shading with closely drawn parallel lines
Reflect	Light bounces off an object
Outline	A line or set of lines enclosing or indicating the shape of an object in a sketch or diagram
Darken	Make or become dark or darker
Shadow	A dark area or shape produced by a body coming between rays of light and a surface
Tone	The light and dark values used to render a realistic object or to create an abstract composition
Proportion	How the sizes of different parts of a piece of art or design relate to each other
Vertical	A line that runs up and down the page
Projection	The way of visualizing different views of an object from different sides (for example front, back, side etc)
Highlight	A point of intense brightness, such as the reflection in an eye
Reflected light	Light that bounces off something else
Circular	Having the form of a circle
Extend	To cover a wider area; make larger

Shading - the darkening or colouring of an illustration

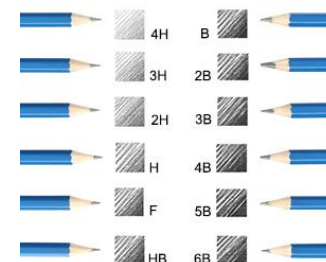


Blend - Merge (a colour) with another
