

Vocabulary	Meaning
Rock	A genre of guitar-based music, usually 4 beats in a bar and quite loud
Band	A group of musicians who write songs and perform together
Call and response	A pair of musical phrases where the second is heard as an answer to the first
Backing vocals	When singers provide harmony lines or other secondary parts behind the lead singer
Improvise	Creating music on the spot
Scale	A sequence of musical pitches used in a piece of music
Pentatonic scale	A scale with five different pitches
Classical music	'Art' music of the western world, using traditional instruments such as the cello and flute
Drone	A sustained sound that continues whilst the rest of the music changes
Sitar	A string instrument used in traditional eastern music that often plays a short, repeated musical phrase
Tanpura	A string instrument used in traditional eastern music that often plays a sustained sound
Ensemble	A group of musicians who perform together
Analyse	To study composition and performance of music
Evaluate	To talk about and describe music

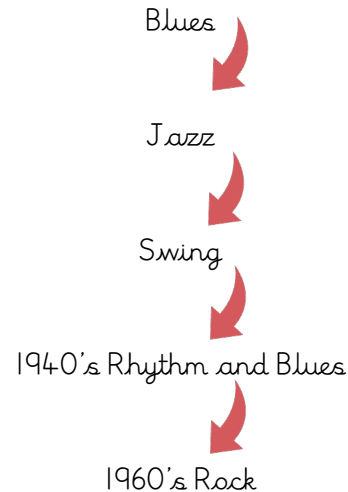


The **sitar** played by Ravi Shankar. The sitar usually plays short, repeated musical phrases, like in 'Lucy in the sky with diamonds'



The **tanpura** - 'tan' meaning melody, 'pura' meaning complete - is used to play a sustained sound or 'drone' throughout a piece of music.
