<p><b>Jesus in the Temple</b></p> <p>At twelve, Jesus discussed scripture in the temple, astonishing scholars. When found, he explained he was in his Father's house. His wisdom left his parents amazed at his understanding.</p>	<p><b>Baptism</b></p> <p>Jesus came to John the Baptist for baptism, but John hesitated, feeling unworthy. Jesus insisted, and as he emerged from the water, the heavens opened, and the Spirit descended like a dove.</p>
<p><b>Calling Disciples</b></p> <p>John the Baptist pointed out Jesus to his disciples, who followed Him. Jesus turned and asked what they sought. They asked where He stayed; Jesus invited them to see.</p>	<p><b>Miracles</b></p> <p>In a storm, Jesus walked on water, calming His disciples' fears. His miraculous power over nature astounded them, affirming His divine authority and instilling awe in all who witnessed.</p>
