With a supportive 1:5 ratio, our knowledgeable early years team provides attentive care while encouraging curiosity and confidence. CCTV operates across all main rooms and in the sleep room, reflecting our strong commitment to safeguarding and security.

All staff undertake key responsibilities—such as planning engaging activities, guiding learning and observing children’s development, progress and attainment—under the guidance and supervision of a qualified or nominated teacher. This ensures that every child enjoys high-quality early education tailored to their needs.

We value the individuality of every child and foster warm, trusting relationships with families and the wider community. Each day is thoughtfully shaped by meaningful topics, children’s interests and a joyful approach to learning that prepares them for the next steps in their early years journey.

OWLS – OUR ENGAGING PRE-SCHOOL ROOM



At Valentine Primary School & Nursery, our Owls Pre-School Room caters to children aged 3–4, offering a nurturing environment that mirrors our Year R setting to ensure a smooth and seamless transition to school. Children enjoy a rich curriculum with core texts and themes aligned with Year R, while continuing to learn through play, fostering creativity, curiosity and a love of learning.

With a 1:8 ratio, our experienced staff provide attentive support, and when Year R teachers join the setting, the ratio adjusts to 1:13, allowing children to become familiar with key adults they will encounter in Reception. CCTV is in place across all main rooms and the sleep area, reflecting our ongoing commitment to safeguarding.

Staff carry out all key responsibilities—planning activities, delivering learning experiences and assessing children’s development, progress and attainment—under the guidance of a qualified or nominated teacher, ensuring high-quality, tailored early education.

We celebrate each child’s individuality and foster strong, positive relationships with families and the wider community. Daily learning is built around engaging topics, children’s interests and joyful play, providing a firm foundation for Year R and beyond.

COSTINGS:

A morning or afternoon session (half-day) is £25.

A full school-day session is £40, with the option to purchase a school dinner (£3.25) or bring a packed lunch from home.

A full-day session is £60, with the option to purchase a school dinner (£3.25) or bring a packed lunch from home.

If you require additional hours beyond a school-day session (for example, collecting your child at 4:30pm), these are charged at £7 per hour.

You can choose to opt in or opt out to pay for consumables or provide your own.

Consumable charges are:

- 50p per nappy
- £1 per day for snack time
- Seasonal items (e.g., sun cream) will be communicated in advance if needed.

Any educational visits or trips will be charged separately based on transport and entry costs. These will also be communicated to you in advance.

All charges will be invoiced with a clear breakdown, including your funded hours entitlement, any additional paid hours, food charges, non-food consumables (e.g., nappies), and any trip or activity charges. This will be invoiced monthly.

We are happy to confirm that we accept the funded hours.
