School Heating and School Uniform

Dear Parents and Carers,

I am writing to update you on the heating situation at school.

Since we asked for warmer clothing to be worn, the weather has improved and this has had a positive impact on classroom temperatures.

We have now had a heating engineer on site, who has been able to identify issues linked to previous repairs and temporary fixes. As a result, the heating has been running more consistently, with some rooms now heating beyond the 19 degrees we have set.

As stated in my initial message, our priority is to ensure that our children and staff are warm and comfortable. Thank you to the parents who contacted the City Council to raise concerns about the heating; we have now been informed that the Councillor with responsibility for Schools and Education will be looking into the issues we have been facing.

It is no longer necessary for children to wear alternative clothing, and we ask that pupils return to normal school uniform for the remainder of the week.

I will write to you again next week with a further update regarding the ongoing management of the heating.
